Surgery Department Visitation Guidelines

In accordance with California Department of Public Health guidelines, visitors are allowed in the surgical pre-op area.

Adult surgery patients are allowed one visitor, and pediatric surgery patients are allowed two visitors.

All visitors must:

- Be screened for symptoms of COVID-19.
- Wear any personal protective equipment (PPE) that facility personnel deem appropriate for the situation.
- Physically distance themselves from facility personnel and other patients/residents/visitors who are not part of their group at all times while in the facility.
- Be 18 years or older
- Wait outside, in a vehicle, or at a different location during the patient's procedure and recovery time.
 - Staff will be in contact with the visitors via phone to provide updates about the patient.
 - Visitors may not use the patient registration area as a waiting area.
